- Tablet devices (iPads, Kindle Fires, etc.), smartphones, and gaming systems are not effective devices as they are not compatible with our current online learning platforms.
- Assignments or tests will not be modified to accommodate issues with personally owned devices.
- The district will not provide technical support for personal devices.
- Students may request to enter the 1:1 Chromebook program at any time by completing the necessary paperwork. Parents/students should contact their building principal.
- Students are expected to follow all school guidelines and policies when operating their devices at school and/or using school resources.
- The district does not accept any liability for personal devices used at school. It is the student's
 responsibility to properly care for and store the device while at school. I certify that I have read

 school.
